'Beginner Stumpwork'

Fee; \$65.00 plus materials Date; Saturday April 9th Time; 10am to 3.30pm 1 session

This is an introductory class to the joys of Stumpwork or Raised Embroidery. Learn the basic techniques of buttonhole stitch leaves, raised berries, covering beads to make currants and stitching beaded boysenberries. For those who have worked the first beginner piece we have a matching piece, 'Beginner Berries II' which includes padded strawberries, beaded blackberries and blueberries.

'Stumpwork Insects'

Fee; \$130.00 plus materials Date; Friday June 3rd & 24th Time; 10am to 3.30pm

This is primarily a sampler class to give students lots of ideas for working insects to decorate embroidery. This class covers; ladybugs, bees, butterflies, snails, ants, spiders and webs, and dragonflies in different sizes and different levels of complexity. Students may work their insects on a sampler piece or on individual fabric pieces, for mounting on pill boxes or to make into scissor fobs or pincushions.

'Stumpwork Initials'

This class allows students to work a beautiful stumpwork initial of their choice. They are worked in a felt padded, raised stem stitch, and decorated with tiny raised, embroidered leaves. You may then embellish further with raised butterflies, dragonflies, flowers or berries. You can choose! The kit includes the full, beautifully scripted alphabet.

'Stumpwork Butterflies'

In this class you may make any stumpwork butterfly you wish. You may work life sized wires butterflies or tiny unwired butterflies. You may wish to make Jan's single butterflies to mount on to pots for gifts or you may wish to start Jan's new kit 'Butterfly Garland' with lots of different tiny butterflies.

In this class students will learn how to create Jan's special appliquéd teddies or bunnies. The animals are machine stitched and then hand quilted onto Australian pure wool blanket. Once the animals are in position we add a colourful garden of wool embroidered flowers. This is a class suitable for both the beginner and more advanced students. Select your project from any of the 'Windflower" Applique kits, including her delightful 'Bunnies in the Berry Patch' design and a brand new teddy design on the way.

Bullion stitch is versatile and fun to master. In this sampler class students will learn all the tricks for perfecting bullion. Students may select to work either sampler in class;

Bullion Flowers; Using beautiful silk threads, we will work rosebuds and 8 different roses, as well as daisies, lavender, and forget-me-knots.

Bullion Animals: In this sampler class we will be concentrating on perfecting bullion animals and insects. Using DMC & silk threads, we will work bullion bunnies, bees, bears, soldiers, trains, boats and more!

'Shadow Embroidery & Madeira Applique Needlecase' Fee \$65.00 plus materials

This class allows students to experiment with a number of techniques on a small project. The needlecase is edged with Madeira Applique and decorated with surface and shadow embroidery using the beautiful floche thread. No previous experience in these techniques is required.

This is a simple one day workshop creating a delightful picture from mother of pearl buttons, trinkets, and silk ribbon. Suitable for beginners, students will learn silk ribbon embroidery stitches such as woven roses, loop flowers, twisted roses, and French knots. Frame the picture, create a dainty pillow or incorporate into a box lid. Students may select to work a heart shape, an initial or a small circular pincushion design.

'Wool Chatelaine'

Create a chatelaine that includes a pinwheel, scissor pouch, thimble pip and pincushion. This class allows you to explore Stumpwork and raised embroidery techniques on a larger scale. Working with wool embroidery threads and beads, the work is easy to see and grows quickly. You will learn to work leaves, stems, raspberries, beaded blackberries, strawberries and a strawberry flower in a variety of woollen threads and beads.

As seen in Inspirations #30, Repair Bear guards your sewing treasures. Create a work pouch embellished with Jan's special appliqué teddies and other sewing delights; a tomato pincushion, strawberry emery, needle packet, and thread spool. In this class students will learn how to make all the appliqué motifs, work the simple embroidery, and make the zippered pouch with Jan's caring and sharing help.

'Catching Wild Butterflies'

Fee \$130.00 plus materials

Jenny McWhinney loves to thread paint and designed this delightful bunny, and Jan Kerton loves raised embroidery and she added the butterflies. This fun 2 day workshop, is a combination of their skills to create a delightful blanket. This is an excellent beginner project for learning to thread paint. Jan will guide you through creation of the precious, blue-coated bunny and share the secrets for achieving beautiful thread painted results. On the second day you will create the raised elements on the project. She will take you step by step through the the creation of the fluffy bunny tail, the woven butterfly net and the exquisite raised butterflies. The project is worked on a cream, bassinette size piece of wool cashmere blanketing. The embroidery is worked in Appletons crewel wool, Gumnut yarns and DMC thread. The kit includes wools, threads, needles, silk organza and fusible web, and full step by step instructions and colour image.

'Thimble Flower'

Inspired by a Martha Stewart magazine where I saw a delicate flower arrangement in a thimble. What a wonderful idea for a stitcher who loves to sew flowers! I have created a series of small free standing stumpwork flowers and leaves that can be arranged in thimble pots. Most of the techniques do not use wire and the results are delicate and realistic. Work violets and African violets and rosebuds. This project will be suitable to frame or to sit in a shadow box. A delightful gift!

'Blackberry Brambles'

Fee \$30.00 per session plus materials

This blanket has been a long time in creation. Inspired by an antique design, Jan has used wool stumpwork techniques to create a rambling circle of beaded blackberries and delightful flowers raised flowers. This project has been worked as an adult knee rug on beautiful wool cashmere but could also be worked on a piece suitable for framing. This will be a monthly class so that students can work at their own pace and attend as many classes as they require.
